Exclamations

¡Qué chévere! – How cool! (Latin America in general)
Chévere – Cool (Latin America in general)
Chilo – Cool (Northern border cities in Mexico)
Chido – Cool (Interior cities in Mexico like Mexico City, etc.)
¡Está padre! – That's cool (Mexico)
¡Está Fregado! – It's messed or screwed up! (Latin America in General)
Es su bronca. – It's their problem. (Mexican slang)

Money

Plata – Money (Regions of South America)
Te voy a pagar la **lana** - I'm going to pay you the **money**. (lana = money)(Mexico)
Baro – Peso (Mexico: “peso” is the Mexican “dollar” and “baro” is a slang word for “peso” in Mexico.)
